PROFILES



Founded in 1969, the **DuPage**Community Concert Band started as a daytime concert band for students and a nighttime band for the community. In 1982, the band was consolidated into one community group. The size of the group has grown ever since.

The band plays two concerts per semester in the McAninch Arts Center Belushi Performance Hall. Membership is open to all high school graduates with woodwind, brass or percussion experience who are otherwise qualified to register. Auditions are required for chair placement, but no one is refused membership. Membership is open each semester in all sections. Call (630) 942-2048 for registration information.

Through music education, and the performance of our music literature, we desire to help facilitate the enjoyment of playing in a band program for all who wish to do so. The exposure to the beauty and expression of music, and the involvement in the activities that are congruent to a person's involvement in the fine arts, will forever enhance that person's life.

The DuPage Community Concert Band program exists to embrace and express all of the beauty and glory we can share with each other through playing great music. We try to program concerts that are entertaining to the audiences, stimulating to the performer, and consistent with the representation and growth of the college and community band medium. The support of the membership, and their desire to perform great music, are the reasons that the DuPage Community Concert Band continues today.

It is our goal that you enjoy the music we will be presenting in our concert. We hope you will like what you hear as much as we delight in performing it for you.

PROFILES



The Chicago Brass Band is a 30-piece brass and percussion ensemble formed in the British brass band tradition, but with Chicago flair. The band, led by music director Dr. Mark A.

Taylor, just celebrated its 20th anniversary. During its first two decades, the Chicago Brass Band has won the North American Brass Band Championship, been awarded Most Entertaining Band at the US Open Brass Band Championships, twice competed in the World Music Contest in the Netherlands, participated in the renowned Whit Friday Marches in England, has been a featured ensemble in front of 40,000 brass fans at the Great American Brass Festival, competed in the 2019 New Zealand National Brass Band Championships, and won first prize at the 2019 Gateway British Brass Band Festival. The band's favorite activity, however, remains dazzling audiences in Chicago, one of the world's premiere cities for brass musicianship. The band has particularly enjoyed performances with soloists drawn from the Chicago Symphony Orchestras celebrated brass section, including Chris Martin, Charlie Vernon, Gene Pokorny, John Hagstrom, and Mark Ridenour, and multiple collaborations with famed artist Rex Richardson. The Chicago Brass Band was selected to be a Chamber Group at the 2011 Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago, with guest soloist Jens Lindemann- rekindling the brass band movement at this annual convention. Additionally, the Chicago Brass Band has continued engaging young musicians with its Project Horizon initiative, a program developed to promote and enhance the performance and enjoyment of live music in public schools. Through collaborative concerts, workshops, and clinics, the band inspires students to continue to perform and enjoy live music at a high level into and throughout adulthood, even if they do not pursue music as their chosen profession.

PROFILES



Mark A. Taylor (Music Director) is honored to serve as the Music Director of the College of DuPage Community Concert Band. A conductor, educator, and performer in demand throughout the Great Lakes region, Dr. Taylor has taught with distinction at every level of study, ranging from elementary, middle, and high school to collegiate, amateur, and professional

musicians. He is Music Director of Chicago Brass Band and Milwaukee Festival Brass, both award winning British-style brass bands, and Music Director of the Waukegan Band, one of America's oldest and most historic civic ensembles.

He received the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in 2016 from the University of North Texas, where his principal conducting teachers were Eugene Migliaro Corporon, Dennis Fisher, and Nicholas Enrico Williams. Dr. Taylor's dissertation, "British-Style Brass Bands in U.S. Colleges and Universities," documented the existence of brass bands in American college music programs, past and present.

Prior to his doctoral study, he served five years as Director of Bands and Coordinator of Ensembles at Loyola University Chicago. During the same period, he taught on the music education faculty at the Chicago College of Performing Arts at Roosevelt University.

Dr. Taylor received the Master of Music degree from Northwestern University, where he studied conducting with John P. Paynter and Stephen G. Peterson; he received his training in music education from renowned pedagogues Bennett Reimer and Peter Webster.

He received his undergraduate degrees from the University of Notre Dame, where his first conducting teachers were Walter Ginter and Carl Stam. His final appearance as Drum Major of the Band of the Fighting Irish coincided with the football team's most recent national championship (1989). He also performed in the Concert Band, Orchestra, Liturgical Choir, Men's Glee Club, and Collegium Musicum.

Dr. Taylor and his wife and son reside in Lake Forest, IL.
