The High Kings, compromising of Finbarr Clancy, Darren Holden, Paul O'Brien and Brian Dunphy have held the position as the distinctive voice of Irish Folk music across the world for the last 15 years.

And as they continue to sell out venues around the world to an evergrowing army of loyal fans, The High Kings show no signs of stopping. 2024 has been a landmark year for The High Kings. They surpassed 1.6 million monthly followers on Spotify. Over 3 million worldwide and garnered over 5 million streams in just one week this March.

In 2023 The High Kings celebrated 15 years together by releasing 15 brand new tracks to their fans, which was followed by the release of their 8th Studio Album 'The Road Not Taken'.

Since its release in June 2023, 'The Road Not Taken' album has achieved over 14 million streams. It has reached the number one position for independent albums in Ireland, number one in Folk, number two across all genres, and number two in singer-songwriter in the USA. Additionally, it has topped charts as the number one bestseller on Amazon Germany and number one on iTunes in Germany, Belgium, and the Netherlands, along with a selection of top five chart positions worldwide.

Standout hits such as "Chasing Rainbows," "The Streets of Kinsale," "Connemara Bay," and the poignant famine track "1845" continue to garner thousands of streams weekly.

In addition to their studio album, The High Kings have shattered records in the streaming world and 18-25YO demographic in 2023. Their remixed songs have garnered millions of streams, with particular appeal for Chasing Rainbows (Badscandal Remix) and Step it Out Mary (Fari Mac Remix) both surpassing 2 million streams in record time, showing that The High Kings enduring appeal transcends generations, attracting fans of all ages to their music.

In addition to their streaming success 2023 was nothing short of remarkable for The High Kings playing to their largest ever audiences across the world. Following their album release they undertook an epic world tour which sold out venues across Australia, Canada, Germany, Benelux, UK and the UAE as well as three tours of the USA.

Mary Black is delighted to be going back to the USA in 2025 for the first time in eight years. Black has become a dominant presence in Irish music, both at home and abroad, bringing her songs and music to

growing numbers of fans, not just in Ireland where she has been a household name for decades, but all over the world. As an award-winning solo artist with multiple chart-topping and critically acclaimed albums, Black has been celebrated by a faithful public as well as fellow artists many of whom she has performed and recorded with over the years, including Emmylou Harris, Mary Chapin Carpenter, Joan Baez, and Van Morrison (celebrated in her latest album 'Duets'). Last year Mary received an Honorary Doctorate in Literature from UCD, and RTÉ presented her with the Lifetime Achievement Award at the RTÉ Radio 1 Folk Awards. Black and her legendary band will celebrate her career playing favorite songs from her extensive catalogue, songs that we've come to know and love over the years.

For the last quarter-century, Black has been a dominant presence in Irish music, sharing stages, tv shows, and recording studios with some of For the last quarter-century, Black has been a dominant presence in Irish music, sharing stages, tv shows and recording studios with some of the most revered performers of her time. She has also played a frontline role in bringing Irish music, past and present, to an increasingly appreciative and ever-growing global audience. *The San Francisco Chronicle* has described her as "One of the best interpretative singers around". To the acclaim and awards, Black has received over the years from both the public and the critics must also be added the esteem.

Coming from an intensely musical family, with her mother a fine singer and her father an entertaining fiddle player, Black first came to the music public's attention in the late '70s as a member of the group General Humbert with whom she recorded and toured. In 2002 Black was the subject of the revealing documentary "Still Believing", which celebrated her extraordinary life in music, tracing her progress from her birthplace in Dublin's inner city on a journey that has seen her conquer the musical world. Its recording was followed by a video of Black and her band filmed on the final night of a triumphant week-long run at the Olympia Theatre in Dublin – one of Black's favorite venues. The British magazine What Hi-Fi? considers Black's voice to be so pure that they have repeatedly used it for comparing the sound quality of different high fidelity systems. In an industry noted for its fickleness and its almost insatiable need for fresh novelties, Black's enduring successes have proven that her depth of talent and her love of singing transcend the generations, as well as national and musical boundaries too.
