on Broadway as "Steve Pieters" in Elton John's Olivier Award winning musical Tammy Faye. Brown was honored to work with Stephen Schwartz playing the role of Adam/Noah in Children of Eden in Concert at the Kennedy Center, and returned to Kennedy Center in 2018 as The Specialist in The Who's Tommy.
